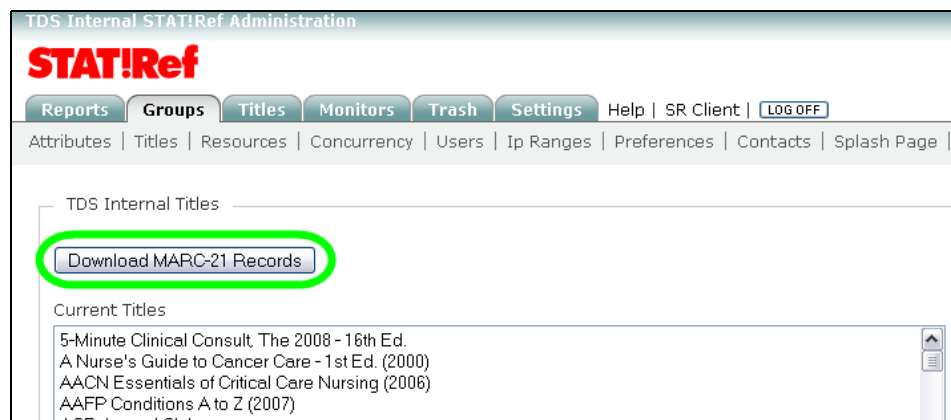


How do I get MARC records for titles in my STAT!Ref subscription?

You may download MARC records directly from SR Admin, as follows:

1. Log in to SR Admin
2. Select Groups > Titles
3. Click on the “Download MARC-21 Records” button (see screenshot below)
4. Save the file to a convenient location



What do STAT!Ref MARC records include?

STAT!Ref MARC records include the following:

- All of the basic bibliographic information, e.g. author, title, publisher, edition, etc.
- ISBN-10 and ISBN-13 numbers for the print edition
- Holdings information for the Library of Congress and the National Library of Medicine
- Library of Congress subject headings, if the title is in the LoC's holdings
- MeSH terms, if the title is in the NLM's holdings
- A direct link to the title

Can consortium members download MARC records?

If you don't have access to the STAT!Ref administrative interface (SR Admin), you will not be able to download MARC records on your own. If you are a consortium member, and would like MARC records for the titles held in a consortium account, please contact STAT!Ref customer support.
