


QUICK START GUIDE

- 1. Logon to your institution's STAT!Ref subscription as you would normally.
- 2. If you have already created your personalized My STAT!Ref account you will find the PALMs product panel on your STAT!Ref homepage. This can also be found on the left hand panel of the STAT!Ref home page. If you do not see the PALMs product panel see #3.





3. You need to login to your My STAT!Ref account, please do so by clicking My STAT!Ref on the upper right hand corner of the homepage and login.
