
The interface consists of three main areas:

Use this panel to select, share and save the content.




2 View panel

Locate anatomy content and find help resources.





Currently this panel contains the title slide. 3D interactive content may be added in future editions.






### Slides

Click on a slide to view it in the View panel.






#### Movies


You can also locate content via alphabetically arranged folders. The type of content is indicated by the icon to the left of the name.





#### **Favorites**


You can save your favorite Slides and Movies into your own folders. You can relocate your Favorites and Favorites folders by dragging them from one folder to another.



The settings panel has controls that relate to 3D Views and clickable slides, so will become relevant once those types of content have been added.






The View panel can display a Slide or a Movie.



# Search/Help panel


Begin typing your search term in the search box – Search results will appear on top of the Help area.


